## SMC WINS ORSA PRIZE

San Miguel Corporation is this year's recipient of the prestigious Operations Research Society of America (ORSA) Prize.

The award is given to a company that has effectively integrated the use of Operations Research in management decision-making.

The ORSA has 8000 members from among the world's top OR practitioners, educators, and scientists. This is only the second time the Prize is being given. In 1990, the recipients were two American companies - American Airlines and Federal Express.

SMC President Francisco C. Eizmendi, Jr. received the award in ceremenies held in San Francisco, California on November 3, coinciding with this year's ORSA/TIMS Meeting. With him were SMC VP and Corporate Technical Services Division Manager Arnaldo L. Africa and AVP and OR Department Manager Elise A. del Rosario.

The SMC OR Department was organized in 1971 and has since helped management of SMC and subsidiaries make decisions in the areas of plant planning, warehouse planning, inventory management, production scheduling, fleet planning, vehicle routing, and forecasting. Under its current head Elise A. del Rosario, the group spearheaded the founding of the ORSP in 1987 and the organization of the first ever International Conference on Operations Research/Management Science (ICORMS) in the Philippines in December, 1990.

## INDUCTION OF OFFICERS

The newly elected members of the ORSP Board were inducted in ceremonies held at the Kalayaan Hall of Club Filipino on August 5, 1992. The inducting officer, Hon. Lilia R. Bautista, Deputy Secretary of Trade and Industry, also delivered the keynote address.

Sworn into office were - President: Manuel M. Agustin of San Miguel Corporation, Vice-President: Felipe L. Fondevilla of PLDT, Secretary: Raul P. Rodriguez of Colgate-Palmolive, Treasurer: Eric V. Bergara of SAS Institute Inc., and Board Members: Dr. Mari-Jo P. Ruiz of Ateneo de Manila University, Rolando Ramon C. Diaz of the University of the Philippines, and Jose S. Victoria of Quantisystems Consultancy Corporation.

Aura C. Matias of the University of the Philippines and Edgar L. de Castro of De La Salle University were originally elected to the Board but rescinded their membership to pursue graduate studies abroad. In his address, ORSP President Manuel Agustin identified the organization's thrusts in the next two years - to make key business decision makers aware of the benefits of Operations Research, to improve interaction between academe and industry, and to organize meaningful activities for ORSP student chapters.
